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# MUSIC NOTES

## Levon Helm Sings!!

It had to have been sometime last year, but the actual date escapes my mind. Sometimes, a revelation, no, a minor musical miracle, has a way of doing that.

At the time, I had heard that the Levon Helm Band was going to appear on the "Imus In the Morning" radio program, simulcast on television by MSNBC. I've been a huge fan of Helm's since his days with the Band, where his voice, along with group mates Richard Manuel and Rick Danko, propelled a storytelling of Americana unmatched by any other popular act. Helm, though, seemed more than a voice, perhaps a conscience, of the stories that the Band foretold, leaning way back, and beyond, his upbringing in rural Arkansas.

For me, if there was a voice to the soundtrack of American history through American music, it was Levon Helm's. And, that voice could take you other places, too, like the frenzy of a Saturday night juke joint followed by a Sunday morning gospel tent revival. Even more so, beyond his singing and playing, I was overjoyed, and stunned, by his acting prowess in movies such as "The Right Stuff" and "Coal Miner's Daughter," the latter of which may, for my money, have been one of the finest, most underrated and understated, acting performances in modern movie history. I saw him perform live more times than I can count, first with the original Band, then, as a solo, and, later, as an acoustic duo with Danko, and finally leading the reformed Band in last two decades of the 20th century.

That is, Levon Helm's century, musically and artistically. And I was a fan, trying to follow his whole remarkable artistic journey.

Then, like many of his fans, I read the devastating news that he was stricken with throat cancer. He would survive, probably as the result, more than anything, of a toughness bred by his Arkansas upbringing and years on the road.

But, the stories said, he would not sing again.

Thankful that I was that this great artist was regaining his health, as a fan, I was quite disturbed that I would not get to hear that majestic voice again. "Don't Ya Tell Henry." "Ain't No More Cane." "The Weight." "The Night They Drove Old Dixie Down." "Milk Cow Boogie." "Junkyard Blues." The closing coda of "The Right Stuff."

And on and on. And, as far as I could see, over and out.

After he regained his health, Helm manned the drum kit again, playing behind a number of combos, finally settling into the current Levon Helm Band, fronted by

the extraordinary harp player and blues singer Little Sammy Davis. They had all but become the house band for Don Imus' show, appearing on it many times prior to last year. Yet, it was a bit bittersweet to watch Helm, clearly enjoying himself behind his kit, but not singing.

So, I taped that show a year ago, and watched it that very night. Sammy sang the first song, and, after a commercial, Imus reintroduced the band. I heard Helm count off the tune, if memory serves it might have been "Don't Tell...Henry," but that really doesn't matter.

The camera came in close on Helm's classic face. He turned to his right, faced into a microphone, and began to sing, as strongly and forcefully as ever.

I got tears in my eyes, and they started to roll down my cheeks.

Levon Helm sings!

For me, and his many other fans, it wouldn't seem it could get any better than that, but it has. Helm has recently made available, via his web site and now in wider distribution, two audio and video volumes of his classic "Midnight Ramble," concerts that take place, with unannounced special guests like Elvis Costello, Emmylou Harris and Donald Fagen, at his Levon Helm Studios barn on Saturday nights in Woodstock. Everyone brings a dish, eats, walks his property and then settles in for the show, seemingly a throwback to his days as a young boy in his native Arkansas, seeing revues like the Rabbit's Foot Minstrel Show perform for locals inside circus tents. The "Midnight Ramble" performances, as these releases show, are stunning.

Even better, Helm has also released, via the site and elsewhere, the audio of the classic 1977 New Year's Eve performance of his first post-Band group, the RCO All-Stars, which included Steve Cropper, Duck Dunn, Paul Butterfield, Dr. John and a host of others, at the Palladium in New York City. The amazing array of talent in that band simply confirms what his fans know-everyone wants to play with Levon Helm, and his talent, and his sharing, and his good will, brings out the best in all of them.

Naturally, I was in the front row for that long-ago concert. Just like, one of these days, I hope to be in the front row for a Ramble, listening to that gorgeous voice tell its stories again.

Levon Helm sings! Yes, it doesn't get any better than that.

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# JUNIOR BROWN

On August 12th Bob Dylan will begin a tour playing in minor league ballparks throughout America. The tour comes to New Britain Stadium, home of the Rock Cats, on Tuesday August 29th. Accompanying Dylan on this tour will be a couple of hot shot Texans named Jimmie Vaughan and Junior Brown. Also on board are Elana James and the Continental Two and Lou Ann Barton. This is arguably one of the best show coming to Connecticut this summer!

It goes without saying that the overwhelming majority of the people buying tickets for these shows are buying them to see the legendary Bob Dylan. Also, many people know of Jimmie because he's the older brother of the late, great Stevie Ray Vaughan. But Junior Brown is a legendary figure himself. He's a clever songwriter with a deep rich voice, not unlike Johnny Cash. He's the guy with that crazy looking instrument called a Guit-steel, which is a combination electric and steel guitar. Just wait until you see him play it. Junior also played the role of the Balladeer in "The Dukes of Hazzard" movie.

After a string of records on the Curb label, Junior has released two outstanding recordings on the stellar Telarc label. "Down Home Chrome" is his latest studio release which came out in 2004. And just this year Junior recorded "Live at the Continental Club - The Austin Experience." This wonderful disc captures Junior in full glory playing to a raucous and enthusiastic audience. I had the pleasure of talking to Junior by phone on the afternoon of Saturday July 9th. Junior was at his home in Texas.

**BH** - You seem to have quite a history of playing at the Continental Club. I'm not surprised that you would record a live record there.

**JB** - "Yeah, they were the one club where I had my weekly gig that I built up over the years and got more and more

successful with. It started out with just a few guitar players in there on Monday nights and then after a while it started getting more people in. Eventually I did a showcase in that club for the South by Southwest music conference and that was what led to my record contract with Curb Records. So I really had a lot of success from that club. Some of that story is on the liner notes from the album."

**BH** - Tell me the story behind that crazy looking instrument that you play?

**JB** - "Well the first one I designed was built in 1985 and then the red one was built in 1995, ten years later. And now I'm working on a third one that has pedals. There was a third one built as a matter of fact but I don't use it very much, it wasn't built by Michael Stevens ([www.stevensguitars.com](http://www.stevensguitars.com)) and it had some design problems but it's a beautiful instrument made out of birdseye maple. But actually the fourth one is going to be the one with the pedals on it. It's going to be more like a pedal steel guitar, bigger with a guitar neck coming out of it."

**BH** - So Junior, I was reading different things about you and thing style of music you play. I heard it described as country, blues, honky tonk, rockabilly, roots rock, Americana, tex mex, and western swing. Am I missing anything?

**JB** - "That's about it! A little bit of everything but if you were to try to sum it all up I'd say the most common thread in the whole thing is traditional country music. All the other things sort of revolve around that."

**BH** - If country music was in a lull back in the eighties, do you think we're in a revival period today?

**JB** - "Remember I said traditional country music. But there have been lulls periodically throughout history but the lull I was talking about was more like live music. But there have been lulls and there have been little resurgences here and there."

**BH** - But do you think we're in a resurgence today?

**JB** - "No. The resurgences haven't necessarily brought us closer to country music. For instance, there was a resurgence when the 'Urban Cowboy' movie came out with John Travolta which around 1980. Everybody wanted to go out and buy cowboy clothes and listen to country music, or their idea of country music, and go to honky tonks and dance and all that. Well yeah, that was a resurgence, but I don't think it did anything for country music really. So you have to sort of look at what the word resurgence and what the word lull really means. It's all subjective there too because it's all whatever your opinion is. My view is that really nothing good has come out of any significant quality since the mid-seventies. After 1975 it was pretty much over for the stuff I like. Not to say that there haven't been occasionally a good song here and there. I think Rickey Scaggs is brilliant at what he does, but then again he went over to the bluegrass thing. He went back to his roots as a bluegrass guy which I think is better for him. But aside from that I don't see any really brilliant guys coming along and carrying it on."

**BH** - A country girl did win American Idol though.

**JB** - "Yeah I kind of like her, Carrie Underwood. I sort of like her because she seems honest and down to earth and sincere. And that's what we've lost. So I think if there is



any hope it's people like that that haven't been tainted by other things. Not to say she does the kind of country I like. I mean she does the kind of stuff they do in Nashville now which isn't my cup of tea. But as far as personality and somebody with feeling and those qualities I mentioned, I think she's good."

**BH** – Tell me about The Dukes of Hazzard. How did that come about?

**JB** – "One of the guys in the film who's a fan of mine, Johnny Knoxville, had apparently thrown my name into the hat, from what I can understand. And they were considering several guys much more famous than I am and apparently they wanted too much money. It got down to Jerry Reed and me and Jerry Reed got the part. And then they called me back like a week later and said Jerry Reed is out for whatever reason and I got it. Burt Reynolds really wanted Jerry Reed in there because they had done 'Smokey and the Bandit' together. So one thing led to another, I don't know if it was money or what it was, but I got it."

**BH** – Tell me how the Dylan tour came about?

**JB** – "I never met him before, we have some mutual friends but apparently he was a fan and wanted me to open up for him so the deal was made through my agent and we did it. So I'm opening for him. Jimmie Vaughan will come on next and then Dylan."

**BH** – Is Jimmie Vaughan someone you've known for a long time?

**JB** – "Yeah, I used to give him steel guitar lessons back in the eighties believe it or not. He was getting interested in steel guitar back then and he liked the Hawaiian stuff which I also like. That's how I got to know him and we've been friends ever since."

**BH** – What's next for you Junior after the tour is over. Will you record another CD for Telarc?

**JB** – "Possibly, I don't know. I've done the two albums with them that I contracted to do so I'm kind of a free agent right now. And I'm not in any hurry, I may to something else with Telarc but I'm not in any hurry to do an album. I'm really a quality control stickler and I want to make sure it's as good as it can be. People get in this big rush to get an album out every year and I think you get a little ahead of yourself. You can get ahead of yourself if you try to put out too much product. On the other hand the audience always wants to hear something new so I'm going to have to get with it so to speak."

Junior Brown was born in Cottonwood, Arizona in 1952. One surprising thing I found out when talking to him was that he lived in Connecticut for a short time as a child. "My grandfather had an artist studio in Westport and I lived in Wilton," said Junior. "That was back in the fifties and we lived next door to Raymond Masse the actor. I remember playing on those big gray rocks from the glaziers up in the beautiful woods and that little jack in the pulpit, you know those plant/flowers that grew out of the marsh. These are the things you remember as a kid especially when you move somewhere else and that 'somewhere else' doesn't have those things." Yeah Junior, Connecticut is a beautiful state and it will be nice to see you back here on August 29th!

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The first time I heard John Scofield was with Dennis Chambers, and it absolutely blew my mind that it was still considered Jazz. Scofield has made a name for himself for quite sometime as one of the pioneers of Jazz-Fusion. But in "Out Louder" it seems that the collaboration between the trio and John Scofield is absolutely perfect. Medeski, Martin, and Wood have created their own sound and distinguished themselves from most other Jazz-Fusion groups. "Out Louder" is an unthinkable mold of Jazz, Funk, Alternative, Experimental, and even a little bit of Latin influence. The quartet opens up with a funky and relaxing number called "Little Walter Rides Again." It is here that the tone of the record is perfectly placed; with all members taking short solos and feeding off each other in perfect unison. Not so far down the road the taste of "Tequila and Chocolate" lingers on our tongue as Scofield manages to infuse Latin Bossa with Jazz and for a little while an Acid Rock solo. But don't think that Scofield is the only one lighting up this track; as John Medeski plays excellent keys on this tune. "Julia" is a peaceful tune with Medeski playing a wonderful organ piece that sounds like the sun setting. Scofield plays amazing on this track and has so much control over what he's doing its astonishing. I don't think I have ever heard Scofield play so quietly and peacefully on a record before.

Of course, because these four guys are masters of Jazz-Fusion, they need to throw in that almost twelve minute song "Down the Tube." A lot of the general public (to my understanding) does not like the "jamming" aspect of these types of songs. However, if you're listening to this record I doubt you're the general public. This song is great and funky in all Fusion aspects of jamming. To be honest I had no idea what to expect with this record because these guys are always changing, and with Scofield in the mix you haven't the slightest clue as to what is about to happen. Each song is different from the previous and not a single one of them will bore you, especially songs like "Miles Behind" and "In Case the World Changes Its Mind." What more to say than this record is damn good, funky, jazzy, and ultimately relaxing? Go buy it.

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Phillips, Leann Rhimes, Paul Stanley, and Olivia Newton-John. And he has been blessed with the opportunity to take the stage alongside some of six-string heroes like Steve Morse, Joe Satriani, Steve Vai, Eric Johnson, Ted Nugent, and Ace Frehley.

Andy Timmons was inspired early by the opportunity to be a session player, admiring the variety of playing styles of legendary session musicians like Larry Carlton and Steve Lukather. Timmons subsequently dug further into the depths of jazz guitar before moving on to Dallas. It was there that the Andy Timmons Band released a number of instrumental recording effort in recent years. "Resolution" is the Andy Timmons Band's first new release on the Favored Nations label.

An enjoyable aspect to "Resolution" is that each track seems to reflect hints of a different guitar influence. The opener, "Deliver Us", for example, carries the majestic classical riffs of Yngwie Malmsteen. "Redemption" is pure Satriani, while "Move On" more reflect the chops Steve Vai. Yet Timmons and company avoid the pitfall of over-shredding by incorporating a variety of jazz influenced selections into the mix as well. "Gone", written on September 11th, 2001, shows traces of Jeff Beck's "Blow By Blow" album. "Ghost of You" clearly has an Eric Johnson flavor. And the final hidden track, "Headed For The Ditch", offers the high energy, crisp note selection of the late Danny Gatton. Bassist Mike Daane and drummer Mitch Marine also deliver an inspired performance from start to finish.

"Resolution" is an instrumental album that emphasizes creative songwriting and a multitude of guitar styles. The Andy Timmons Band effectively deliver a high-energy recording that's enjoyable listening throughout. With the hair metal days of Danger Danger now secured safely in his past, Andy Timmons has moved forward to become of the most promising guitar virtuosos today.

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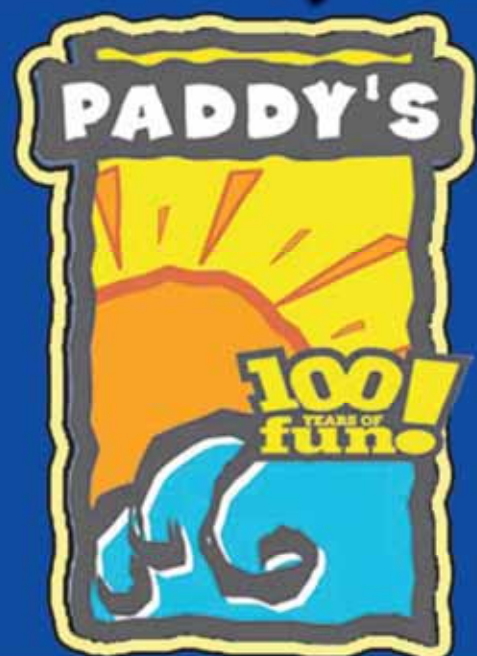
