**It's Finally Finger Poppin'
Time**

**With The Queen of The
Blues**

Who's the best female blues singer? That's a pretty tough question to answer, huh?

Purists and historians might suggest Memphis Minnie, Bessie Smith, or Billie Holiday. Those from the Fifties and rock era might offer Big Mama Thornton, Janis Joplin, or Etta James. You might even toss in the two great Bonnies, Bramlett and Raitt.

But, for me, there's always been one far above the crowd. Lou Ann Barton.

You might be thinking "Lou Ann who?" about now, and therein lies a problem. For this spectacular Texas blues belter is far from a household name, and to me, that's an absolute travesty of musical justice, because there's just about no one out there who can sing like her.

As it is with so many great things, I can't really recall how I was first exposed to Barton's talent. I do recall going out and getting her first record, 1982's "Old Enough," when I was in law school out West, so I'm thinking that I probably saw a reference to her in a music magazine like Rolling Stone, or, maybe, the Sunday music section of the Los Angeles Times, which I devoured for tidbits and references to great, new music in those days. I do recall, though, being mighty impressed that "Enough" was co-produced by Atlantic Records wunderkind Jerry Wexler and Eagle Glenn Frey.

And, let me tell, you, it rocked, baby, from the toe-tapping rendering of the classic "Finger Poppin' Time," the very special "Brand New Lover," to bluesy pathos of "It's Raining." It was, and is, just an absolute smash from beginning to end. (It's just been re-released, by the way, on American Beat Records, so check it out if you are still asking "Lou Ann who?" Believe me, you won't be disappointed.)

I became hooked on Lou Ann Barton that day, and have been a devoted fan ever since. But, in the two and a half decades that have passed, as countless, far less talented singers have had hit records and then faded away, Barton has remained a comparative secret outside her native Texas. But, it's not really like she's been hiding out in some witness protection program. Although her recorded output has been curiously meager, she nonetheless has helped punch up the sounds, both in the studio and on stage, of none other than the late Stevie Ray Vaughan, the Fabulous Thunderbirds, and Roomful of Blues, with her signature "take no prisoners," thundering, steamroller-powerful voice.

And, since she tours infrequently and in the East next to never, I'd never had the pleasure and good fortune to see Barton in concert. The closest I ever came, and it really

wasn't even that close, was about five years ago, when she had televised appearance on "Imus In the Morning" with Jimmie Vaughan, with whom she's toured on and off for several years. She was great, like always, but seeing her seated before a stationary microphone in a studio at 7:30 in the morning just didn't seem to do her anything close to justice, and made me all the more anxious to her in concert.

Thankfully, after much too long a wait, it happened. Vaughan, with Barton in the band, opened for Bob Dylan's recent show at the Mohegan Sun Arena. I had a great seat, in the side section right next to the stage, about six rows up. Vaughan came out first, with the band, and showed all us Easterners what Texas boogie and blues is all about. Then, he said those magical words that I had waited so long to hear:

"Let's hear it for Miss Lou Ann Barton."

Out she came, looking as tasteful and classy as that well-worn voice I'd listened to so much over the years. And, although she only sang four songs, she was well worth my 25 years wait. No sass. No put ons. Just that power and presence that I always wanted to see.

My only regret, on top of the fact that it took too damn long to get to see her live, is that we were in a big arena, because that powerful, yet intimate, voice is probably better suited for a smoky bar, with about half a dozen Texas longnecks perched in front of me.

If there's any luck, that'll be where I'll see the incomparable Lou Ann Barton next time, and, hopefully, it will be in far less than 25 years.

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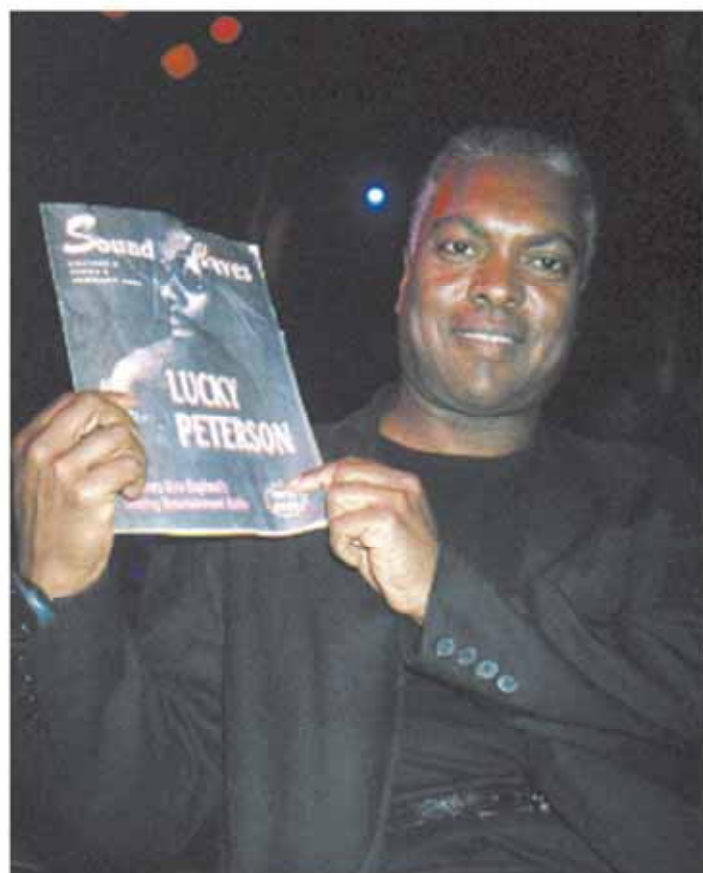

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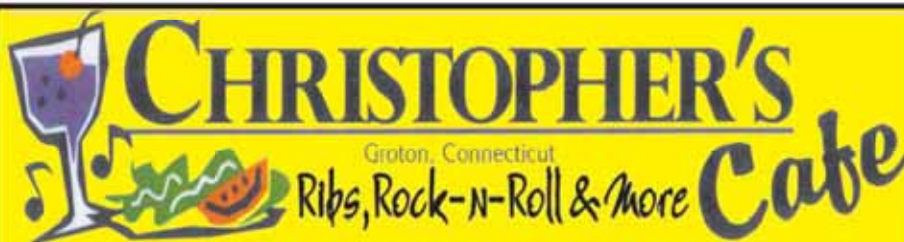

Having reached the half-century mark with two years to grow on, Al DiMeola is not trying to sound like the proverbial grumpy old man complaining about the music of "the younger generation."

For one, the pioneering jazz artist is not old for his early 50s.

For another, his optimistic, energized art is far from sour-mood-inducing.

It's just that he has been asked to assess the quality of the music scene in general and he wants to respond from his own truth. "It's ridiculously bad," the New Jersey native replies candidly. "Yes, the kids need to find musicians with talent that have something to say, rather than what has become popular and is rather lame musically."

The artist doesn't say, but many others would agree, the music of Al DiMeola would be an excellent starting place.

His is a story of challenging his, and our, growth, not settling for what is convenient, what may be the most accessible commercially.

What might a new artist or band learn from his career so far?

"To reach high and be the best hopefully," he suggests. Certainly the award-winning DiMeola has.

He played drums first, then switched to guitar at 8. By his early teens, he was an accomplished instrumentalist who was comfortable in several genres, including rock, pop, jazz, bossa nova and some classical.

He recalls, "I had all this technique that my friends couldn't understand. It never fit the kind of music that they were playing." He felt drawn to the marriage of rock and jazz that was taking place as he explored his talents. He would ride the bus from Jersey to see guitarist Larry Coryell, whom he later dubbed "The Father of Fusion," play in Manhattan clubs.

DiMeola began practicing his guitar eight to 10 hours a day between his junior and senior years in high school. He studied bluegrass, especially Doc Watson, jazz and other forms. "I wanted to do something new, something nobody was doing," he explains.

He enrolled in Berklee School of Music in Boston in

1971. It's said his marathon practice sessions are still being talked about. He was playing in a fusion quartet led by keyboardist Barry Miles by the second semester.

In 1974 he received a call in his Boston apartment from Chick Corea who invited him to New York City for a rehearsal. He recalls that in 10 minutes he packed some clothes, got a ride to New York and never saw his apartment again.

The band he was rehearsing for turned out to be the seminal Grammy winning fusion group, Return to Forever. After a weekend of playing together, DiMeola made his debut with the group at Carnegie Hall. The next night he played to a crowd of 40,000 in Atlanta.

Intimidating? "I was on tranquilizers," he quips.

There was Corea on keyboards, Stanley Clarke on bass, Lenny White on drums and DiMeola on guitar. "It was the first group to incorporate jazz with rock and classical elements in a sophisticated fusion," DiMeola says.

It disbanded in 1976 after three successful albums, and DiMeola began his solo career, which has included three gold albums and sales of six million records so far. Over the years, he has recorded with an all-star list of players, including Paul Simon, Phil Collins, Santana, John McLaughlin, Paco De Lucia, Luciano Pavarotti, Steve Winwood, Wayne Shorter, Herbie Hancock, Gonzalo Rubalcaba, Jaco Pastorius, Les Paul, Jean Luc Ponty, Steve Vai, Frank Zappa, Jimmy Page, Tony Williams, Stanley Clarke, Stevie Wonder, Irakere and many others.

He says he has learned from everyone with whom he has worked. And it's another impressive assemblage he has brought together on his new Telarc album, "Consequence of Chaos." His core players are keyboardist Mario Parmisano, drummer-percussionist Ernie Adams and percussionist Gumbi Ortiz. His guests include Chick Corea, drummer Steve Gadd, keyboardist Barry Miles, bassists John Patitucci and Victor Miranda and percussionist Kornel Horvath.

The result, DiMeola believes, is perhaps the best album of his career. He says his group has been playing many years together around the world, and their love of playing is even more evident on this recording. "We grew over the years and it seems more evident here. It took total dedication," he explains.

He wanted to capture a higher level of energy.

The CD heralds his return to playing solid-body electric guitar in the context of modern concepts and composition. He says he loves the energy and the fact that he has reconnected to his first love.

That instrument brings something special to the artistic table, he believes. "The sound is connected on a spiritual level. The feel and touch and sound are inherent in my soul since I was eight years old," he explains.

DiMeola says he approaches a guitar as a rhythmic instrument first. "As a rhythmic player I can say that my approach has been unique," he says.

He is elated with Corea's participation on the record,

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saying it's some of the best playing he has ever heard from him. DiMeola says his duet with him on "Cry for Me" was one of the best interactions he has ever had with any musician.

DiMeola had some great interaction through the years with the late David Baker, his recording engineer to whose memory he dedicates "Consequence of Chaos." "He was a genius. He would totally know instinctively what was happening and I would get way, way more done with him than anyone else because of his connection and discipline."

DiMeola tries to maintain enough discipline to search for new inspiration in his writing. Motivation isn't difficult, he suggests. "My vision is still in tact so I see further horizons," he says.

He hopes he is thought of as an artist who creates "interesting contemporary instrumental music." "My music reflects all emotions and appeals I believe to many on a lot of levels," he adds. "People connect because it reaches their core."

On September 30th, Al DiMeola will be performing with 2 other jazz pioneers – violinist Jean-Luc Ponty and bassist Stanley Clarke – in an extraordinary evening of acoustic jazz called The Rite of Strings.

Jean-Luc Ponty is a pioneer and undisputed master of violin in both jazz and rock. He has collaborated with Frank Zappa, Elton John, and John McLaughlin's Mahavishnu Orchestra. Stanley Clarke has played with such famous bandleaders as Horace Silver, Art Blakey, Dexter Gordon, Joe Henderson, and pianist/composer Chick Corea, with whom he formed the jazz/fusion band Return to Forever.

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HEARING AID

TRACY NELSON

"You'll Never Be a Stranger at My Door"

Is it any surprise that one of the country's greatest blues singers can wrap herself so perfectly around an album's worth of country standards, thereby making them her own?

Not when it's the remarkable, and criminally underrated in my book, Tracy Nelson.

Actually, this strong record is a return of sorts to a genre that Nelson explored back in the Sixties, when she fronted the excellent, yet woefully commercially unappreciated "Mother Earth."

In her notes accompanying the album, Nelson writes that over 20 years ago, she began to make a list of country songs that she'd like to record. For one reason or another, perhaps mostly because her career took her in a more blues-based vein, they remained just that, a list, until she took another long at them. And, thankfully for her fans, she went into the studio and recorded them.

The songs she has chosen typify her talent, and her taste. They include a wonderful reading of the standard "Cow Cow Boogie," the Johnny Cash-penned weeper "I Still Miss Someone," Ernest Tubb's classic "Thanks a Lot," Don Gibson's "Oh Lonesome Me," and the Everly Brothers' "I Wonder If I Care As Much." Nelson also performs "Salt of the Earth," an original she co-wrote with Guy Clark and Alice Newman Vestal.

It took more than two decades to get these wonderful performances recorded and released, but Tracy Nelson made it more than worth the wait.

JIMMY THACKERY AND THE DRIVERS

"Solid Ice"

Telarc Records

Blues guitar slinger Jimmy Thackery recently took a brief hiatus from the road to renew a focus on songwriting. The end result is "Solid Ice," an eleven track, 62 minute offering of soulful harmonies and driving rhythms from the well-seasoned Thackery, who can effortlessly deliver a half dozen different musical styles with effectiveness.

Thackery is best known for his 15 year stint as co-founder of The Nighthawks. Now with nearly 20 years of solo experience under his musical belt, Thackery has

truly found his six string zone, offering a relaxed collection of tracks that incorporate the musical elements of jazz, rockabilly, country, and soul. "Blue Tears", for example, bleeds the influence of Thackery's recent Nashville visit, while "Hobart's Blues" is pure Texas shuffle from beginning to end. Then there's the Mexican-acoustic rhythm of "Daze in May", eliciting memories of a sun-filled, tequila drinking afternoon. In fact, it's the instrumental tracks, with plenty of creative melodies and soulful rhythms, where Thackery truly shines. Three more instrumentals close the set; the slow, jazzy title track, a bit more slow honky-tonk with "Blue Tears Reprise", and "Who Knows", a lesser-known Jimi Hendrix cover that clearly demonstrates that the fire hasn't strayed too far from Thackery's guitar. Bandmates Mark Bumgarner (Bass) and Mark Stutso (drums) mesh perfectly with Thackery's change of pace and varying styles.

Overall, the efforts on "Solid Ice" are creative and diverse, with Thackery demonstrating his well-thought note selection and soulful tone throughout. Guitar fans will surely appreciate Jimmy Thackery's "Solid Ice" for its depth and diversity, with a thorough collection of well-crafted music from a guitarist that has truly mastered his craft.

WALT WILKINS & THE MYSTIQUEROS

"Diamonds In the Sun"

Palo Duro Records

As the author of popular songs like Pam Tillis' "Someone, Somewhere Tonight," Ty Herndon's "Big Hopes," and Ricky Skaggs' "Seven Hillsides," San Antonio-based Walt Wilkins had already made quite

a name for himself. Now, with the release of his own work, "Diamonds in the Sun," a solid collection of originals and tasteful covers, his own recorded career would seem to have the same upward trajectory as he's provided others who have been fortunate enough to

record his songs.

Produced by Lloyd Maines, the album includes six typically strong songs co-written by Wilkins, including the stand-outs "Get Me Gone," "All These Memories," and "Quiet Moon." Among the covers is a great reading of The Band's "The Shape I'm In," Ray Stephenson and Bob Dipiero's "Honky Tonk Road," and Davis Raines' "Big Shiny Cars."

At times sounding like the country rock of Poco and the Flying Burrito Brothers, and the classic acoustic blending of Crosby, Stills & Nash, and then veering, without missing a beat, into blues and even soul, "Diamonds" is virtually impossible to pigeon-hole. Just call it great music.

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GUITARIST BILL PERRY DIES AT AGE 49

With great sadness, Blind Pig Records announces that New York guitarist Bill Perry died on Tuesday, July 17th. According to Greg Schwark, Perry's road manager for seven years, the musician was found at his apartment in Sugar Loaf, NY. Emergency medical personnel tried to revive Perry, but he died on the way to the hospital, an apparent heart attack victim, although no official cause of death has been determined.

Perry was known as an outstanding guitarist whose go-for-broke technique combined effortless fluidity and incredible attack. Guitar One magazine called him a "six-string superman more powerful than a locomotive." He was also gifted with a distinctive, raspy voice full of grit and gravel that particularly suited the drama and emotion so essential to blues music.

Perry first made his mark in the clubs of New York City in the 1980's, where he was spotted by folk-rock singer Richie Havens. Perry spent four years on the road as the featured guitarist in Havens' band. During the same period, he also did some touring with The Band's Garth Hudson and Levon Helm. In 1995 he signed a deal with Pointblank/Virgin and released two albums for them. In 1999 he released a live album recorded at New York's blues hotspot, Manny's Car Wash. In 2001 Perry released the first of four titles for Blind Pig Records, with Jimmy Vivino, music director of "The Conan O'Brien Show" serving as producer on the first two CDs.

Good friend and labelmate Popa Chubby produced Perry's next two releases for Blind Pig, the most recent being 2006's Don't Know Nothin' About Love. Upon hearing the news while on tour in Germany, Popa said, "The best thing about Bill was that his talent was effortless. He was a natural. He could sing the phone book and draw you in. He didn't have a mean or a bad bone in him. I never heard him say a bad word about anyone. He was a brother and I'll miss him dearly."

Richie Havens issued a statement, saying, "I'm shocked and saddened to hear the news. Billy was a great friend, a truly gifted guitar player, and one of the funniest people I've ever known. Our times on the road together were some of the best times I've ever had." Havens recorded a haunting

acoustic duet version of the Rolling Stones' "No Expectations" with Perry that appeared on Bill's 2002 album Crazy Kind Of Life.

Buddy Fox, Perry's manager for four years and the long time booking agent for Manny's Car Wash, said, "Bill was a very singular and unique talent. He had a natural blues voice, and an uncanny ability to sing at the same time that he was playing a virtuoso guitar solo."

Blind Pig President Edward Chmielewski said, "We are indeed saddened by the loss of Bill and his incredible talent. His intensity on the guitar was frightening. He was a mesmerizing performer who played with passion and excitement, and he had that wonderful sandpaper voice that you could listen to forever. Truly a unique artist that will be missed."

Perry, age 49 at the time of his death, is survived by his only son, Aaron, 25, three brothers, and a sister. Details of a memorial and funeral have not been announced.





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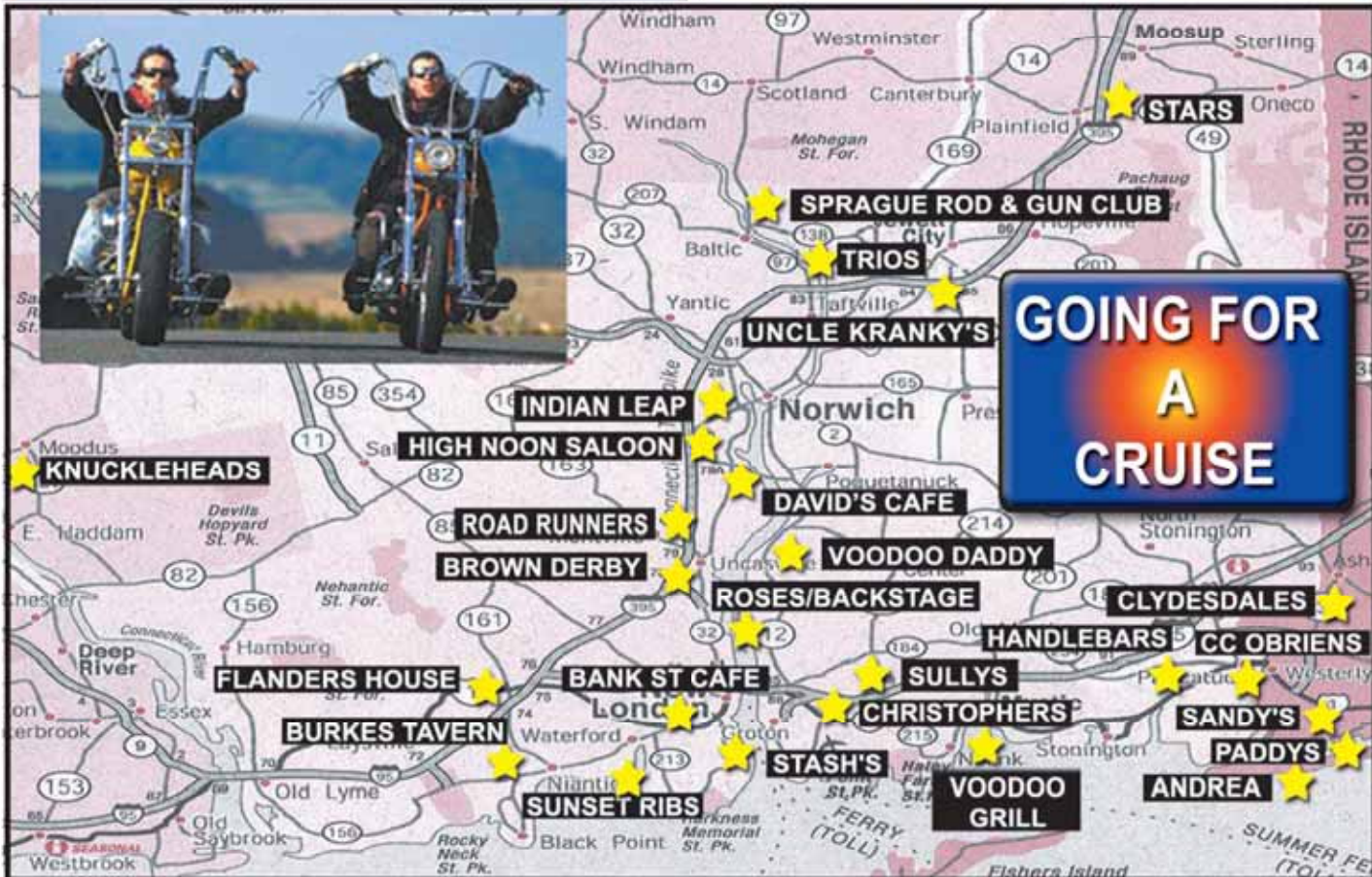

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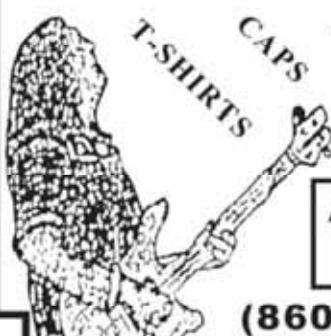
