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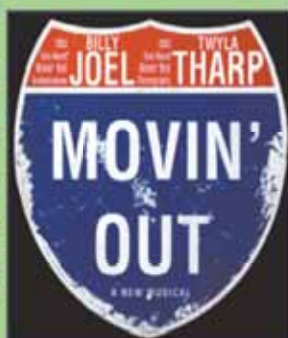

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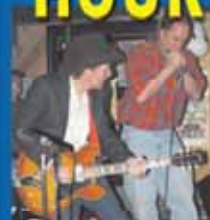
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MUSIC NOTES

"Good 'Evening' America, How Are You?"

My friends told me that I was crazy, but I knew better. It was an album that I had to have, and I'd overspend a bit to get it.

I was at a record album auction, in the early 70s, near the college radio station where I worked as a disk jockey. The auctioneer held the record up, and I jumped up and yelled out "six dollars!" That was a lot of money to me in those days.

"Could have it for a lot less," one cynical bidder chuckled around me. "Stupid bidding," another muttered.

No way, I thought, for a record, any record, by Steve Goodman was well worth the price, just about any price.

And, I was right.

You might be wondering just who is this Steve Goodman, and why was he worth my six dollars at the time? If his name rings a bell, it's probably because of his most famous song, "City of New Orleans," the "train song" that's so much more than a "train song," which was a sizable hit for Arlo Guthrie in the early 70s. But, if you stop there, you miss much of the genius that was, and is, Steve Goodman.

Never mind that Steve Goodman was one of our great songwriters. Never mind that he was one of the finest guitar pickers I ever saw. Never mind that, in a musical era reeking of pure, unadulterated and vastly undeserved ego preening, he was one of the most gracious, giving and kind performers out there. Never mind that accomplished all that did while he carried the burden of a fatal disease that he fought nearly half of his life, that ultimately killed him, far too young, at age 36.

He was truly all of those things, but the diminutive Steve Goodman, all 62 inches of him, was much more than that. Elfish in height, he was a giant of an entertainer, in the truest sense of that word.

Now, thankfully, almost 25 years after his ultimately death after a long battle with leukemia, Goodman's amazing story has been told, in stunning detail, over 700-plus oversize pages, including an exhaustively detailed discography, songwriter history, and even a magnificently performed and extremely well recorded tribute CD from his friends, in Clay Eals' "Facing The Music," published by ECW Press.

Call it "the great, big book about a great, big, albeit short, talent." You can't say "tiny," because, as this book aptly points out, page after page, there was nothing "tiny" about Steve Goodman.

Now, wait a minute, you might think. Couldn't the story about one guy, who never had a hit record and who wrote only one song that became a hit, for someone else, be told in far fewer pages? Frankly, I thought the same thing,

when I started into this opus.

But, the more you get into the book, the more you realize what a special treasure Goodman was, to his friends, his family, and, most important for those of us who called ourselves his fans, his audience. Based on that, there's nary an extraneous word in there. Put that with the fact that Eals did over 1,000 interviews (that is not a misprint), and it's clear that this was one hell of a life, and, in turn, one hell of a story.

Once you get into it, it seems quite obvious that 700 super-size pages of this magnificent book aren't nearly enough to tell Goodman's story.

So, who was Steve Goodman? As this wonderful biography aptly points out, his music and his songs told an awful lot about him, but while they revealed a great deal, they were only part of his story.

To find out just who he was, you have to start with the songs. You'd be wise to begin with the very first song on his very first album, "The I Don't Know Where I'm Going, But I'm Going Nowhere in a Hurry Blues," or, maybe, his own version of "New Orleans," from the same record, which gives a more plaintive cry to Americana than, ironically, Guthrie's hit version ever did. Or, you might listen, and be stunned by, the caring and beauty of his love letter to his wife, "Would You Like to Learn to Dance."

Then, there's his second album (that's the one I overbid for, and won for the six bucks), including "Chicken Cordon Bleu," the hilarious "Lincoln Park Pirates," (you'll never guess what 'municipal service' it's about, unless you either live in his native Chicago, or read Eals' book) "The Ballad of Penny Evans," (which, still, unfortunately, resonates loudly in these troubled times), and the exhilaratingly exhausting "The Auctioneer," which more than lives up to its title, and just might validate my six-dollar purchase.

That's more than enough classics for one songwriting genius' career, but we can't leave out some later classics like "Door Number Three," his rave-up of a classic game show; the absolute show-stopping (literally) closer "Mama Don't Allow It," the masterful, and orally exhausting, "Talk Backwards," (it's about just what it says it is), the ultimate country song "You Never Even Call Me By My Name" (usually performed by Goodman while wearing a mega-sizes too big cowboy hat passed up from the crowd) and, of course, the magical baseball gem, "A

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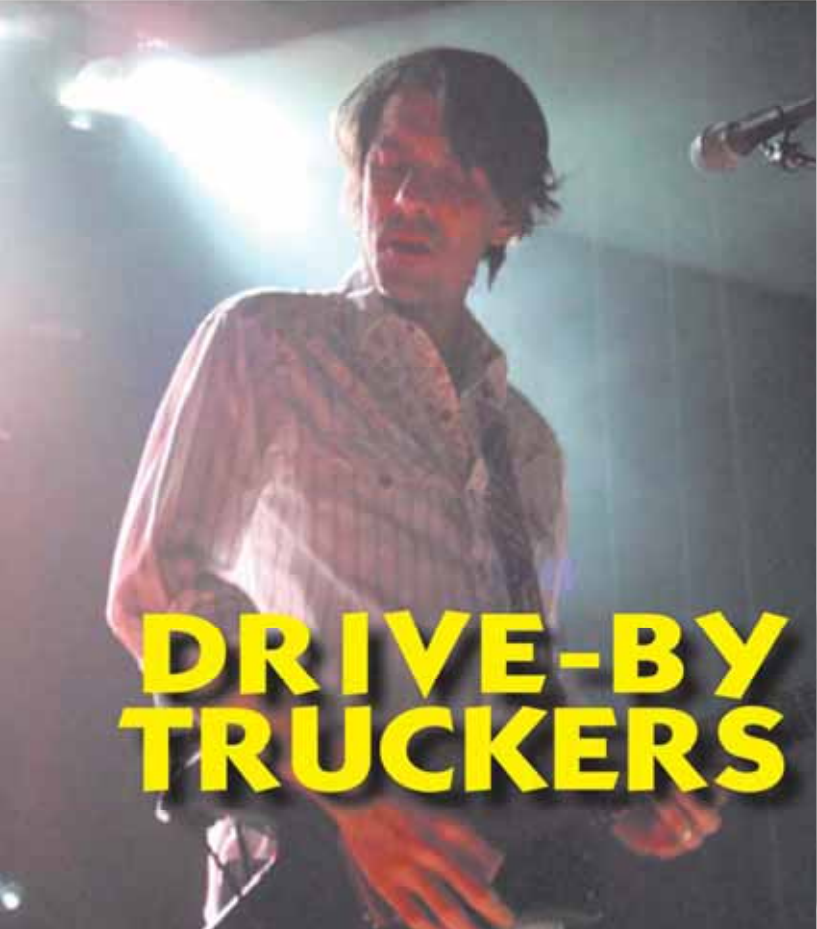
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DRIVE-BY TRUCKERS

What a year it's been for the Drive-By Truckers. Another in a long list of great bands from Athens, Georgia the Drive-By Truckers are a good old fashioned rock and roll band who are as popular with the alt-country crowd as they are with the jam band community. They have a new CD out called "Brighter than Creation's Dark" and it is being hailed as the best work of their illustrious career. It's a nineteen song set of original music that is available on CD as well as vinyl. (Remember the days of double albums?) Anchored by founding members Patterson Hood and Mike Cooley, DBT also features Brad Morgan on drums, Shonna Tucker on bass, and John Neff on guitar and pedal steel. Joining the group for the new CD is the legendary Muscle Shoals keyboardist Spooner Oldham.

The surprising thing about this outstanding new CD is that it comes so soon after the departure of guitarist Jason Isbell. Jason was a big part of the band over the last five years but personal and creative differences brought about the need for change and the parting, which happened in April of 2007, was both amicable and mutually desired. The band responded by going out on the road for a series of semi-acoustic shows nicknamed "The Dirt Underneath" tour during which time many of these new tunes were written. Also, the band found time to go into the studio to back up the legendary blues woman Bettye LaVette for her new studio recording called "Scene of the Crime." This record went on to be nominated for a Grammy Award for the best contemporary blues album. DBT also worked with Spooner Oldham on this record and Spooner kept right on working with them all the way through the

completion of "Brighter than Creation's Dark." In fact the Drive-By Truckers hold Spooner in such high regard that they actually dedicated the new CD to him.

"Brighter than Creation's Dark" which clocks in at just over seventy-five minutes in length really is a revelation. Mike Cooley penned seven cuts from the pure country of "Bob," to the rip roaring rock of "3 Dimes Down" and "Self Destructive Zones." Patterson Hood has nine contributions including two cuts that make statements about the Iraq war called "The Home Front" and "That Man I Shot," the latter sounding a lot like Neil Young and Crazy Horse in their prime. The remaining three songs were contributed by Shonna Tucker who adds a woman's touch to the proceedings.

The Drive-By Truckers are now on tour in support of the "Brighter Than Creation's Dark" recording. They will be in the area on March 21st in Northampton, March 22nd in Boston, and March 25th at Toad's Place in New Haven. This interview with Mike Cooley took place on Thursday February 7th. Mike was at home in Alabama at the time.

BH – Congratulations on the new CD!

MC – "Thanks, thanks it's been cool."

BH – The reviews have been great.

MC – "Yeah I've probably read more for this record than I ever have in the past. Most of it gets forwarded to me through email and I've come across a few of them by accident and that's kind of cool. I had some surgery a couple of weeks ago and I was laid up and my wife just brought a few magazines in there to kill some time and I've come across a few reviews, even one that wasn't a good one. The cool thing is that some of the ones I've come across that are even borderline less than favorable are still overall really good reviews so I'm not complaining."

BH – It must be nice getting ready to tour the new songs when you know your fans finally have the CD in their hands.

MC – "You know news travels faster than bullets. They were singing along to those songs from day one. We would play a show, literally, play one of those songs live for the first time, play the next show the next night and people were singing along to it. I mean that's how fast this shit travels now. You can't keep it a secret."

BH – You must be proud of your new songs.

MC – "Yeah it was the first really good creative run I've had in really almost ten years. So it felt really good to pry some of those doors open and actually get back in to doing what I really like which is seeing a song come together."

BH – How was it working with Spooner Oldham?

MC – "You know it's been a great year all the way around and working with Spooner has more to do with that than anything. He's just great and he kind of became a member of the band. We have an open door policy, you don't even have to call first just show up. He's just great, what he adds makes the songs better. No matter how good it is to begin with, he makes it better. And he's just a wonderful, warm human being to hang out with."

BH – Will he be touring with you

MC – "I'm not sure how many shows on this tour we're

going to have him. We have him whenever we can and whenever he wants to. We generally try to have him as much as possible but I don't know yet how much or when."

BH - I noticed that you'll be playing at Toad's Place. Have you been there before?

MC - "I don't think we played there. I think the only Connecticut show we've ever played was some little tiny bar, it might be right by Yale. We had a ball that night but we played in a room that was about the size of my living room." (I think Mike was referring to Café Nine.)

BH - I also noticed that you're starting out the tour playing with the North Mississippi All-Stars. That's a hot little band don't you think?

MC - "Oh yeah, we've known those guys Luther and Cody (Dickinson) since they were kids. They've always been amazing. They came right out of the gate hot."

BH - It seems that the jam band community has really embraced you guys

MC - "Yeah, that's kind of cool. From the beginning the alt-country crowd embraced us for a while and they still do. We've been able to be embraced by a lot of these different genres without burning any bridges or without getting pigeonholed in any one of them. I'm glad they're opened minded enough to appreciate a song that starts and finishes in a timely fashion."

BH - And I think it helps that you guys are a taper friendly band too.

MC - "Yeah, we always have been. Why try to stop it?"

BH - I see that you're headed back to Bonnaroo again?

MC - "It will be our third time there."

BH - Is that a festival that you look forward to?

MC - "Oh sure, I don't know if Zeppelin is going to play it or not but that could almost get me off the bus and back into the festival. Usually when we do a festival I stay on the bus, I get into a golf cart, I go to the stage, I play the show, I go back to the bus because I hate crowds. But if Zeppelin plays I might get off my ass!"

BH - Yeah but Mike, what happens if you become so successful that you have to play to sold out hockey arenas?

MC - "I don't mind those kind of crowds! The reason I started doing this is so I can be on stage, it's not crowded up there."

BH - Let's talk about the new record for a minute. Patterson wrote two anti-Iraq songs. Are you two on the same page politically?

MC - "Well I live in Alabama so a voted a few days ago but we're very much on the same page. What I'm most proud of, what political statements were made weren't opinionated on this record. I feel like we just said 'this is what this guy sees through his eyes.' You can't disagree with it, it's what he sees. I like that because it's not like preaching from a soapbox."

BH - I like your song "Bob." You write about this character without passing judgment on him.

MC - "I was goofing off when I wrote that song. I wasn't really taking anything that seriously and we cut it and I didn't really plan on it going the record but the rest of



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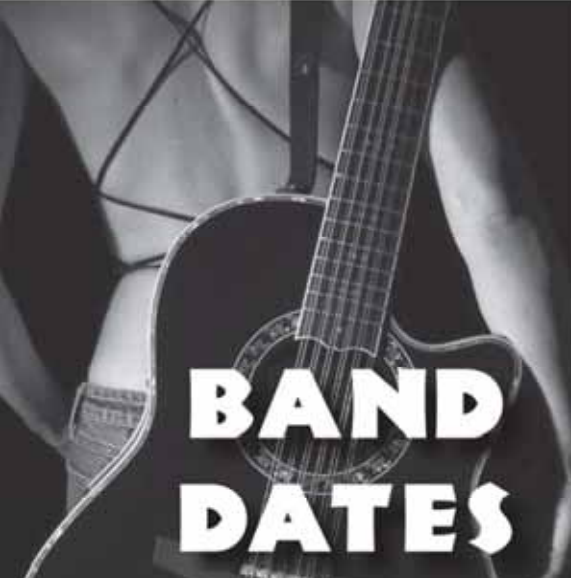

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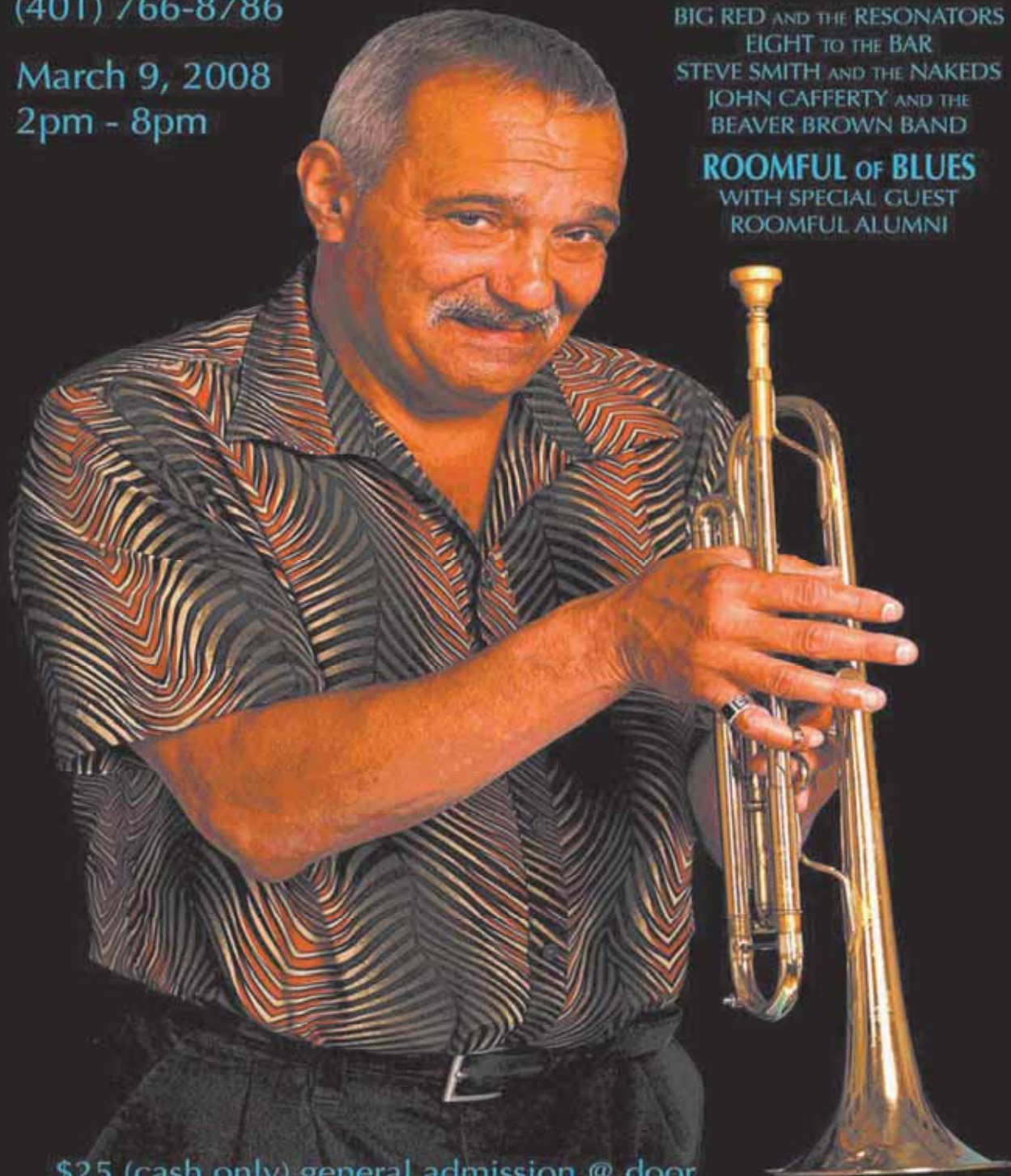

the band really liked it and now it's become the one that everybody is singling out. OK cool."

BH - It's amazing that the Truckers haven't missed a beat with the departure of Jason Isbell. But I guess as long as you and Patterson are together the band will always have its anchor.

MC - "We've had a lot of people come in but we've been fortunate enough to have mostly really talented people, people with a lot to say and a lot to offer. And eventually a person who is that talented and has that much to say and that much to offer will find their own way. I'm proud to have been a part of all those people and their ambitions."

BH - Shonna Tucker certainly took a big step forward.

MC - "Yeah, that's just great. The songs she came in with are great. I don't think we would have gotten away with having nineteen songs on a record if it hadn't been for those three because you get one of Patterson's, one of mine, one or two here or there and then you get this gem that's different. And then it happens again and then it happens again. It really serves the placement to draw people back into the record. I think it's amazing."

BH - I understand that you'll be releasing this music as a double album as well as a compact disc. Does vinyl still sell?

MC - "Well it's starting to again. For the last couple of years I think vinyl is going to become, as far as a physical and tangible format or product to buy and hold in your hand and collect, it's going to reemerge as the one. Even people younger than us who didn't grow up with it are now embracing it as just a better product to have in your collection. If you want to hear the music you can download it and you can put it straight on your ipod, if you just want to hear the songs. But if you want the product vinyl is just superior, it's nicer, it's better, it's bigger, it's cooler, and it sounds better too."

BH - You've always had great artwork on your discs and "Brighter Than Creation's Dark" is no exception. I'm sure it will look even better on a nice big album.

MC - "It always does and that's because of our connection and friendship with Wes Freed. We happened to meet this guy who is a phenomenal artist real early in the development of the band. And we knew that we wanted him to do this work. You look at CD's and even the nicest packages just don't have it. And now, lo and behold, here comes vinyl back. So I can't wait to see all these records and all that artwork on that LP format."

BH - With this record out will you be able to take a break from the songwriting process or is that a continuous thing for you?

MC - "It's a continuous thing. It's my favorite thing to do. I'm just not always able to immerse myself in it as much as I'd like to. I hate taking a break from songwriting. I don't really have the time anymore or the ability just to drift into that world and let it happen. But right now I'm happy. I'm glad I got the songs on the record and we have it to tour behind and that's what I'm going to focus on but I'm looking forward to getting to the next step and writing some more songs for the next record."

Some have called what the Drive-By Truckers do "storyteller rock." Their lyrics are always intriguing and provocative and the musicianship is flawless. There are times when their sound moves effortlessly from southern rock to punk to blues and back to country. Patterson Hood once said that the listener should just consider it rock and leave it at that. Still, as good as their new studio CD is the Drive-By Truckers are a band that you need to see live in order to get the full aural experience. There's a ton more where those wonderful songs came from, but, as you read this book, you will learn that there was an awful lot more to Steve Goodman than his magnificent way with words and with a tune. The story is replete with tales of times he offered to give money back to concert promoters when he didn't sell out venues; when he had a kind, and often just the right, word for friends and even adversaries and competitors; and, most of all, his glorious fighting spirit, right to the very end, as he battled his ultimately fatal disease.

I didn't have the pleasure of seeing Steve Goodman in concert until the early 80s, when he opened for his good friend and longtime confidante John Prine at a show in

Portland, Oregon, where I was attending law school. Goodman's picking, humor, cleverness and absolutely stunning stage timing literally stole the show. I laughed so hard I couldn't see straight, except when I was crying so hard over his beautiful songs that I, well, still couldn't see straight. It was one of the few times in my life when I remember an opening act getting such a heartfelt standing ovation. Clearly, I was in the presence of a unique greatness.

I laughed and I cried that night, just as I did when I heard that Steve passed away, just a few, short years later. I cried over the loss of that short, entertaining giant, and I laughed over the way he approached the challenges of his all too short life, which is documented in abundant detail in this superb book.

And, I'm still laughing and crying every time I think about or listen to this glorious entertainer, whose magical gifts are perfectly captured in this great, big book about a great, big, short performer who left us way too soon, but whose legacy, thanks to Clay Eals and his interviewees, lives on in all its glory.

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HEARING AID

JOHN FOGERTY

"Revival"

Concord Music Group

"You can't go wrong if you play a little of that Creedence song". These telling lyrics from John Fogerty's most recent recording effort, "Revival", paint the perfect picture of what we are about to hear. And what we're hearing sounds like pretty solid stuff.

Fogerty, the former Creedence Clearwater Revival front man and lead guitarist, returns to the recording world with renewed vigor to deliver "Revival", his first studio album since 2004's "Blue Man Swamp" and sounding as sharp as ever. John Fogerty is clearly in his comfort zone delivering that familiar swamp-influenced classic rock and roll twang with a touch of toughness and attitude that makes the listener wonder why the great C.C.R. band didn't stick around just a little longer back in the day. Fogerty is on, and lyrical references to the past lead us to believe that his is comfortable where he is and where he came from. In "Gunslinger", for example, Fogerty sings of "all the things that made us great got left so far behind". Whether this is a CCR reference or not, Fogerty is clearly more comfortable with his legacy in his former band that he has been in quite some time.

"Broken Down Cowboy" is outstanding in its simplicity, as only someone with John Fogerty's talent can make it work so right. "Somebody Help Me" is bold and ballsy in its delivery, backed by thumping rhythms and intense vocals. Even the political impact of the angry "I Can't Take It No More" links Fogerty to his musical heyday of the late sixties. In truth, John Fogerty has never been closer to his swamp blues, folk and country rock roots than he is on "Revival".

"Revival" as a title sums up where John Fogerty's musical career presently stands and brings our minds back to a day where Creedence Clearwater Revival's music filled the FM airwaves. No doubt, today's world of rock and roll music is a much more authentic place with the presence of John Fogerty amongst us. And we're glad to have him back in fine form here.

"The Jewish

Americans Original Television Soundtrack"

Rounder Records

Evoking a broad array of emotions, The Jewish Americans Original Television Soundtrack, is the heartfelt musical composition for the recently aired six-hour PBS series, The Jewish Americans. Produced by David Grubin, the story highlights a 350-year history of Jewish immigrants becoming part of American life. It details the traditions, the conflicts and how the people have adapted over time while still preserving their culture.

Composed and produced by the accomplished musician, Michael Bacon, each piece of this classically styled instrumental flows smoothly together, providing an enriching journey, both intense and rousing. Inspired by Jewish religious and folk music, the score ties together a melodic, spiritual, and at times, eclectic mix of jazzy and folksy sounds, but is primarily a suite with deeply moving strings, woodwinds, and brassy undertones. Bacon

has scored the music for a dozen feature films, and been recording and touring for almost 40 years. Over the last 10 years, he has been part of the folk-rock Bacon Brothers band, releasing four original CDs, a live CD and companion DVD.

While too many individuals to mention, there are a group of ten musicians and vocalists supporting the CD in addition to Bacon. Playing an orchestral mix, including violin, clarinet, oboe, trumpet, saxophone, flute, drums and even some accordion, the group creates a mesmerizing trip that flows gracefully throughout. Daniel Singer, Senior Cantor of the Stephen Wise Free Synagogue of New York, and Clare Muldaur Manchon, provide some neatly placed backing vocals interspersed through a few of the pieces on this CD. The vocals primarily set a mood rather than standing out at the forefront of any of the music. Bacon, a guitarist in his band, plays at least six different instruments on the CD, most outstanding being the cello and harmonica, but also keyboard, banjo, and percussion, and of course an adept guitar.

All in all, the soundtrack, a complex and multi-layered score, stands firmly on its own as a wonderful experiential piece.
